2018 HOLIDAYS THAT ROSEY'S WILL BE CLOSED

January 1, 2018- New Years Day
May 28, 2018 - Memorial Day
July 4, 2018 - 4th of July
August 31, 2018 - Staff in-service Day
September 3, 2018- Labor Day
November 22 & 23, 2018- Thanksgiving Holiday
December 24 & 25th, 2018 - Christmas Holiday

The above listed dates are paid holidays for Rosey's. These are the only days Rosey's will be closed pending an unforeseen circumstance. Rosey's is generally open even when the schools are closed for "snow days".

All Year End Tax Statements will be available the week of January 7th, 2018. We will place them in alphabetical order in a file box outside of our office. My Federal Id number and your year total will be on the form. This is all you will need for your taxes.
