

## SEPTEMBER 2017 NEWS LETTER

Well another summer went by so quickly. Now we are all getting ready for the hustle of another school year. The spray pad at Rosey's will officially be closed on Thursday, August 31st. The kids had a great time out there this summer and really took advantage of our warm days. Don't forget with school starting back up on Tuesday, September 5th, the high school traffic will be back from about 6:40 to 7:10. September is also the month we charge the Annual Registration Fee. This fee will be charged the week of September 11, 2017. The Annual Fee amount remains the same as last year (\$100.00). With the school year starting back up the extra programs will start again. Information and registration sign up will be posted on the bulletin board outside our office for you to register your child for Spanish, Soccer, Tumbling and Martial Arts.

at 9:30AM. We will give you more information in October. Our Annual Breakfast with Santa will be held on Saturday, December 9<sup>th</sup>. We will remind you of these dates, as the times get closer.

The purpose of our in-service day is to prepare for the transition of children to their new classes. We update the equipment in the classrooms and make any changes necessary for an easy adjustment for everyone.

This year in our 3 and 4 yr. old preschool we will be adding the STEM program to their curriculum. STEM has been put into the curriculum in the elementary schools and is the future of these kids. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) will teach them the basics they'll need to succeed later in life. These kids will be our next Engineers, Astronauts or Scientists. The kids will be planning and designing structures every day with little teacher direction. They will work with a computer, identify simple machines like gears, wheels and pulleys. They will be matching shapes and creating patterns. We will continue with our group time, story time, project and the use of all of our motor skills. The kids will be very busy during the day having fun and learning. We will add the "A" to STEM to make it STEAM to include art/project every day also. Please have your child here no later than 8:45 AM so they will be able to participate in all of the activities starting at 9:00AM.
