

## NOVEMBER 2017 NEWS LETTER

The crazy/hectic time of year is starting. The Halloween parade is done and now we are preparing for Thanksgiving. The kids loved all of their Halloween projects, songs, parade and party. Now they will start learning all about the Pilgrims and Indians and, the best, Turkeys!

Please make sure your child has weather appropriate clothes in their cubby in the event they need to change. Make sure you include socks and underwear. Also, with the weather cooling down, we want to make sure the kids have all their winter outerwear with them. Please bring gloves, hats and heavy coats. When the snow starts they will also need snow pants and boots. The kids will go outside every day unless the temperature is below 20 degrees. This includes the wind chill factor also. Make sure you label everything because all of the kids seem to like the same boots, coats and gloves. The fresh air is great for the kids and we do not want to keep the whole class in because a couple kids did not bring their winter apparel.

This is a reminder that Rosey's will be closed on Thursday (Thanksgiving), November 23<sup>rd</sup> and Friday, November 24<sup>th</sup>. During the winter months the schools will sometimes close due to inclement weather. Rosey's very rarely closes. We can't seem to get on the TV stations school closing lists so our best way to notify you that we are closed is to put it on our website. I can assure you that it is VERY rare we have ever closed so it is safe to assume we will be open unless we are out of power. If you have a sibling who is school age or already in our latch key program they can come to Rosey's for the day so you can go to work. We will have an extra latch key teacher available to work.

I would like to take a moment to remind everyone that Rosey's closes at 6:00PM. We have been having a lot of late pick-ups lately. If the weather is bad or there is some type of delay on the roads, we do understand. But when there are no delays and everyone has made it on time to pick up it then becomes apparent to us that this delay is your own fault. We also have kids of our own that are in different functions in the evening or that have to be picked up from somewhere at a certain time. When you are late that makes our commitments even later and sometimes our

own kids are left somewhere. We will be issuing the late fee for all late pick-ups unless there is some type of emergency or major delay that everyone is encountering.

I am attaching the form for the "Annual Santa Breakfast" This will be held on Saturday, December 9th at 9AM at Canton High School right across from the Center. Everyone is invited and you can bring your family members if you choose to. This is a pancake and sausage breakfast with our special guest, "Santa". Every child will have the opportunity to sit on Santa's lap and you are very welcome to take pictures. Santa will give each child a little gift to take home. Please fill out the form and turn it into the office so we have an accurate count for food. Hope to see everyone there. This will be our 30<sup>th</sup> "Breakfast with Santa" and every year is even better than the last!

We will also be having our Thanksgiving Feast for the kids on Monday, November 20th. We will have turkey, mashed potatoes, stuffing, etc. and they will wear their Pilgrim or Indian hats that they made in class to the Feast.

I want to remind everyone to please hold on to your children in the parking lot. The children are not allowed to run in the building and they should not be running in the parking lot. Someone is going to get hit by a car. To avoid this we ask you first, to drive slowly and second, hold on to your child and do not allow them to run in the parking lot. Running in and out of classrooms or all around the building at pick up time is also not an option. We have kids dumping out toys in the classrooms that are already cleaned up for the night and not picking up the mess they just made. If we see them, we will stop them and make them wait for their parent.
