May 28, 2012 – Memorial Day

The above listed dates are paid holidays for Rosey's. These are the only days Rosey's will be closed pending an unforeseen circumstance. Rosey's is generally open even when the schools are closed for "snow days".

This is a reminder that it is the time of year that we use the black bags to place your child's outerwear clothing in. We do this to help stop the spread of head lice. This is a very big problem in the elementary schools and many of the kids here have siblings in school. We have found, in the past that the black bags have worked to control the spread of lice. With that said, after the kids go outside, their outerwear is generally wet from the snow. Please take the wet clothing home and dry it for the next day. If you leave their clothes in the bag wet they will mildew and smell. We would not want your child to have to wear mildew clothing. The bags should be kept here. If you take it home please return it in the morning. Your child must have a black bag for their outerwear.

Please make sure your child has a complete extra set of winter clothing in their cubby in the event they need to change during the day. We hate to put kids in shorts when it is 10 degrees outside.
