

Rosey's Summer Camp

At Rosey's Summer Camp every day holds something new and exciting for your child. Each day will consist of a combination of arts and crafts, games, sports, cooking activities, special events and field trips.

All the children will be able to participate in the Reading Rocket program. We encourage the children to continue to read throughout the summer. The children will be reading books or having books read to them. We will keep track of each book the children read. Each book read will be one step closer to an end of the summer surprise!! There will be time provided at camp for the children to work on this as well as at home.

The first week of camp the children will vote on a name for the "Camp". The children will also be Tye-Dying T-shirts to wear when they are on the field trips. We have planned many fun activities and field trips for your child. Many of these activities are planned for outdoors. If weather does not allow us to be outside, we will make arrangements for an inside activity.

A typical day at Rosey's Summer Camp:

6:30-9:00	Arrival at camp (breakfast, games, small group activities)
9:00-9:30	Keeping fit routine (exercise)
9:30-12:00	Morning journey (includes field trip or special activity)
12:00-12:30	Lunch (might be at park)
12:30-1:00	Reading rocket
1:30-4:00	Afternoon journey (arts and crafts, sports, group activities, snack, free play outside and special event)
4:00-5:30	Game time (group games, individual games, outside games)
5:30-6:00	Dismissal (games, small group activities)

What your child should bring to Rosey's Summer Camp

- A lunch from home. On park days, please make sure everything can be thrown away and nothing would need to be heated up. EX: brown paper bag, zip lock bags, juice boxes, etc.

- An afternoon snack.
- A water bottle. This will be labeled and you can leave it here all summer for outside time and park trips.
- **SUN BLOCK!!** We are outside a lot in the summer and it is very important for your child to wear sun block every time we go outside. You may leave a bottle here and we will label it.
- Children are able to bring toys of their own to use when there is "in between" time, and when some children are done with an activity before others. Each child is responsible for what they bring in. Everything should be clearly labeled with their name.

Each child will receive a calendar of events. The calendar may not include all of the activities planned that day, but will tell you any field trips the children will be leaving for. It is important for you to let us know if your child will not be attending a certain day. Please call before 8:00am if you know your child will not be attending. We need an accurate count for the field trips we are planning.
